Eliza McNulty is Stewardship Manager at YMCA of the USA, the national resource office for the network of 2,700 local YMCAs. In this role, she manages a portfolio of corporate and foundation national partners, monitoring program progress toward deliverables in grant agreements, monitoring spending, writing reports, assisting with re-grant processes and recognizing donors. The stewardship team (there are four stewardship managers) is currently working on a year-long stewardship plan to engage corporate and foundation donors beyond the grant agreement, applying tactics typically used to steward individual donors to corporate and foundation donors.

Eliza has more than 15 years fundraising experience in health care, university and national membership offices, including positions at Loyola University Health System (Director, Communications & Donor Engagement) and the Elks National Foundation (Programs & Development Manager). In these roles, she created comprehensive, integrated stewardship programs that included donor recognition, engagement activities, endowment reporting, special events, alumni relations, and donor communications.

Eliza was elected to the Association of Donor Relations Professionals (ADRP) board of directors in 2014. She has presented at several ADRP conferences and served as content co-chair for the 2012 ADRP international conference. In addition, she served on a task force convened to discuss ways to increase ADRP membership diversity and was a member of the Sheryl Blair scholarship committee. Eliza received a Sheryl Blair scholarship to attend the 2013 ADRP international conference.
