Earl Price, assistant director of donor relations at Duke University Medical Center, was named the 2008 recipient of the Kelli Tate Morris Award. The award was presented at the Seventh Annual Southeast Donor Relations Conference by the 2007 recipient, Cary Henderson, director of donor relations at University of South Carolina, and the 2006 recipient, Denise Howard, director of donor relations at Davidson College.

The Kelli Tate Morris Award is presented to a donor relations professional who exemplifies the qualities of leadership, service, integrity and accomplishment that Kelli epitomized throughout her career and especially in her relationships with donors and her colleagues. Kelli Tate Morris loved donor relations and held development positions at Winthrop University and Furman. She was involved in the efforts to create the Southeast Donor Relations Conference, believing that donor relations professionals should come together as colleagues to share and learn from one another.
